Consideration is given regarding overhead wires, depth to groundwater, location of underground utilities and/or sprinkler system, distance from other trees in close proximity, etc when deciding which trees can be considered for a particular location. Most trees are planted in the Fall. An asterisk denotes the trees that can only be planted in the Spring.
