- AREA 2 -** Tuesday - North of Merrick Road and East of Broadway
- AREA 3 -** Thursday - South of Merrick Road and East of Amityville Creek
- AREA 4 -** Friday - South of Merrick Road and West of Amityville Creek

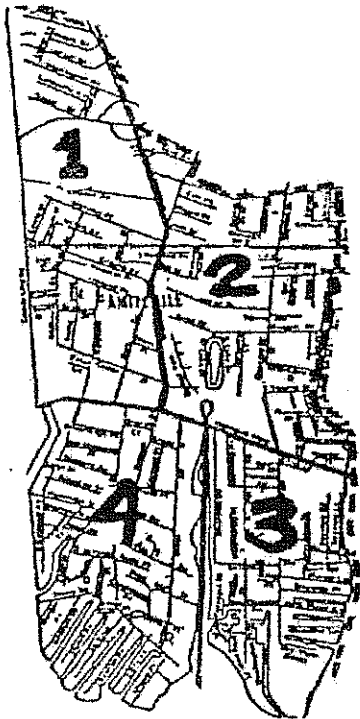

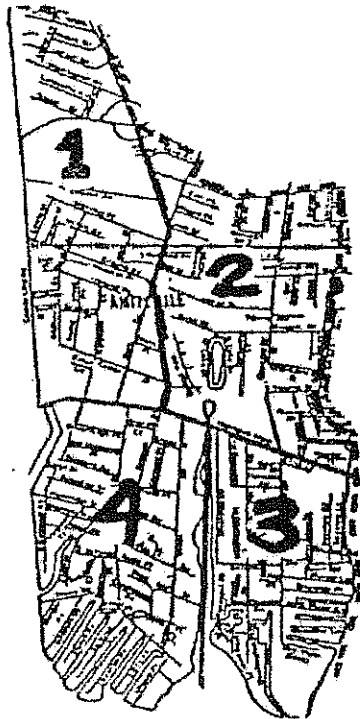

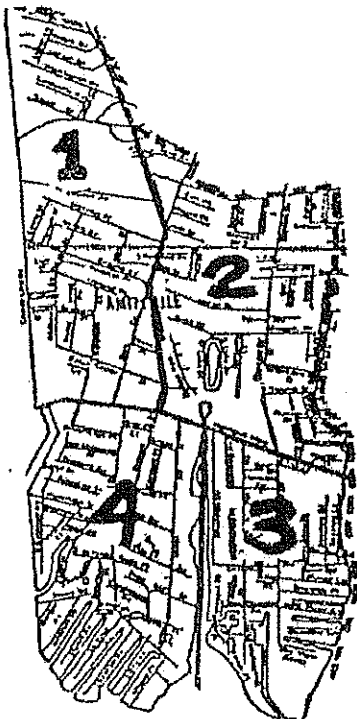
