APPLICATION OF MATT CALVO C/O BUILDING BROTHERS. Applicant seeks a sign variation to legalize the installation of two "Metro by T-Mobile" awnings pursuant to Section 24-6 A (1) (j) of the Village Code. Premises located on the Northwest corner of the intersection of Broadway and West Oak St in a B-1 Retail Business District known as 204 Broadway a/k/a SCTM#101-3-5-12.

Mr. Calvo explained that the purple awning, which is already installed, is the signature color of Metro by T-Mobile and is used at most of their locations.

Chairperson Jealous-Dank responded that their color choice is not an acceptable color for the Bay Village theme. She explained that they can use their logo or colored logo letters on an approved background color.

Brian Williams, Triangle Sign Services, made the following points;

- 1) There are 352 awning sites across the county. In the NY metro area, there are 56 purple awnings. These awnings are the signature awning which customers have come to recognize and look for.
- 2) The fabric that is approved for T-Mobile sites is Cooley-Brite, which is a fire-retardant fabric with limited color choices. There are no fabric color choices that are close to the paint choices the Board has approved.
- 3) There are two other awnings near the site which are not approved color choices.

Chairperson Jealous-Dank reiterated that The Board will not allow the purple awning and stated the Board is revamping the signing codes. The Board it trying to clean up the Village and the signs are a very important part of that.

Joan Donnison, Bay Village Civic Association, stated that they would appreciate a more charming look to the site.

Chairperson Jealous-Dank moved that the Board **deny** this application and suggested the applicant reapply with approved colors. She stated the applicant has 30 days to remove the awning.
