Dear Resident,

I am pleased to inform you that your street's roadway is scheduled for repaving in the next 48 hours, weather permitting. Your street's paving is being done in conjunction with the Village's \$2.0 million project which will vastly improve our Village's roads, all while the Village continues to comply with the 2% Property Tax Cap.

In order to accomplish this project as efficiently as possible, we need your help and cooperation. As such, please take the following into consideration:

1. During working hours (Monday thru Friday, 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM) your street will be open, but access will be very limited.
2. Please do not leave any vehicles parked in the roadway or in your driveway during working hours. If vehicles are left parked in the road, they may be towed.
3. If possible, park on the nearest cross street not under improvement, a minimum of 100 feet from the corner. Vehicles left parked on driveways will, at times, not be allowed out for several hours.
4. Please adjust your plans for deliveries and other daily functions.
5. Please avoid having water flow from lawn sprinklers, car washing, etc., into the street from your property during working hours.
6. During non-working hours, you will have unlimited access to your street.
7. Please contact the Department of Public Works at (631) 789-2200 with any inquiries you may have.
8. Overnight parking tickets will not be written in areas while the paving is being done. Once paving is complete, enforcement of the overnight parking ordinance will be enforced.

Please be aware that at times traffic in the work zone will experience delays. The Contractor will have flag people in the work area to control traffic - please follow their instructions. Thank you in advance for your anticipated cooperation!
