## Village of Amityville

### Local Law No. 1 of the year 2019

A local law to amend §107-45 of the Code of the Village of Amityville to require home improvement licenses for landscapers.

**Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Amityville as follows:**

Section 1. The Board of Trustees finds that because of the nature of landscaping functions commonly provided to property owners, it is appropriate that landscapers licensed in the Village also have a home improvement license from the County of Suffolk in order to properly safeguard said owners within the Village utilizing their services.

Section 2. §107-45 of the Code of the Village of Amityville is hereby amended to read as follows:

“§107-45 Regulations

The following rules and regulations shall apply:

A. No person shall receive a landscaping license from the Village, nor shall any such license be renewed without such person having a duly issued and valid Home Improvement License from the Suffolk County Department of Labor, Licensing & Consumer Affairs.

B. No person shall engage in the application of pesticides and insecticides unless that person has in his possession a certificate, duly issued to him by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation authorizing him to engage in such activity.

C. Landscaping work may be performed by landscapers only during the hours of 8:00 a.m. through 7:30 p.m.. Monday through Saturday, and 11:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m. on Sundays.

D. No landscaper shall scatter, nor in using any mechanical or electrical blower, cause to be scattered, any garbage, cuttings, leaves or other waste materials on any public street, road or public property or on the private property of someone other than the one for whom work is being performed without removing and/or cleaning the same immediately, nor shall any of such material be allowed to enter any storm drains, canals or rivers or other waterways.

E. No one shall spill or dump oil, gasoline or other petroleum products or any pesticides on a public street, road or highway or right-of-way, on the ground or on the private property of another person. No equipment shall be filled or refilled except over a drop cloth or other device designed to catch and retain any accidental spillage.

F. All vehicles and trailers are to be properly parked at a minimum of 30 feet from the corner of any intersection. Hazard warning cones are to be placed at the front and rear of any landscaping vehicle and/or trailers that are parked in or alongside the roadway.”

Section 3. This local law shall take effect immediately.
