COVID-19 Update:

Dear Neighbor,

When we started this Mayor's Message newsletter, I had every intention of not making these emailed communications a nuisance, so I did not want to send them too frequently. But due to the situation here in the U.S. and around the world, I would like to keep you all updated, the best we can, with any information we have. Hopefully, everyone is following the news and abiding by all the regulations being implemented by the government (with good reason): Social distancing, which includes NOT having large, small or medium gatherings, washing hands frequently and sanitizing hands when washing isn't available. If anyone in the family is symptomatic, please stay home and quarantine yourself on a precautionary basis.

The Village has been joining daily conference calls with County Executive Bellone to keep updated. The Village HAS declared a State of Emergency and Declaration of Local Emergency. We will be conforming to the same guidelines as NY State regarding their Executive Order.

The County is still in the process of establishing a drive through testing location, which is yet to be determined. They are allowing residents to call and set up an appointment for mobile testing. The hotline number is **1-888-364-3065**. If you call, you will be triaged by a nurse. Testing will be prioritized by seriousness, with those experiencing symptoms first, those that have been exposed to an infected person next, and so on.

We will continue to keep you informed. Please stay safe and healthy.
