Greetings,

I want to thank the Department of Public Works employees for their outstanding work on clearing the debris from last week's storm which ranged from storm preparation to clearing debris in the many hours and days that followed. The crews were prepared, determined and tireless and we thank them for all they are doing to help our residents out with curbside removal of tree limbs and vegetation that fell from the high winds. To date, they have collected a massive amount of debris: 1,500 cubic yards of wood chips, 3,500 cubic yards of mixed brush, and 300 cubic yards of log wood.

Please note, however, that after this Friday (8/14/20), there will be no further pick up of yard waste by the Village, as our DPW crews need to return to their regular duties throughout the Village. Any remaining yard waste must be put to the curb on your regularly scheduled yard waste pick up day, through the Town of Babylon's trash contractor. Yard waste must be separated from regular garbage, securely tied and bundled, under 4 ft. long/max weight of 50 lbs each. Tree branches must be less than 4" in diameter. Dirt, sod and rocks cannot be accepted. For more information, please call EnCon – 631-491-3200.
